III. Items A through E listed below were the topics of discussion.

A. Legal Updates

Legal Counsel Matthew Buchanan discussed the recent ACLU lawsuit. He stated that the lawsuit is now over. Counsel Buchanan also discussed the Joseph Kelsey Opinion. He stated that the Opinion ruled that no action will be taken by the Court. He noted however that the opinion was critical of the Board's decision.

B. Four Member Quorum Review

- Chair Frederick requested discussion of Four Member Quorum. The Board previously altered their practice as outlined in the Board's manual on March 4, 2020, to reflect a minimum of four members present to conduct proceedings (previously a minimum of five members present were needed for proceedings to be valid).
