PPP DIRECTOR JERRY ADGER TO BE SWORN IN BY GOV. HALEY

Columbia – Gov. Nikki Haley will swear in Jerry Adger as Director of the SC Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services Friday, June 5. The ceremony will take place at 10 a.m. at the SC Supreme Court, 1231 Gervais Street Columbia.

The SC State Senate voted unanimously in March to confirm Adger as Director of the Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services.

Adger has had a diverse background in criminal justice. His extensive career spans over 30 years, specializing in law enforcement tactics, program management, strategic planning, and achieving organizational goals.

He began his career with the Federal Bureau of Investigations as a Fingerprint Analyst. At the SC Law Enforcement Division (SLED) he served 23 years working in several capacities, including Fingerprint Examiner and Fingerprint Instructor, Special Agent of Investigations, SWAT Team Member, Internal Affairs Investigator and Community Relations Liaison. Adger went to the SC Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) in December 1999 to direct the newly established Office of the Inspector General. He was South Carolina's first nationally certified Inspector General, receiving his certification at the American University in Washington, D.C., through the Inspectors General Institute.

The SC Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services supervises some 32,000 persons serving criminal sentences and others serving sentences from other states under the Interstate Compact. There are approximately 650 employees of the agency.
